## 2020 SUMMER CAMP

*Hello Parents and Campers, summer is almost here! Thank you for enrolling your child in our summer camp program. We will stay cool this summer, as well as learn new skills, make new friends and most of all, have FUN!*

### **Here is a check list and some reminders / updates for your child's summer skating experience**

1. Please be sure all emergency phone numbers, contacts, registration form and allergy info is handed in before the start of camp.
2. Sign out procedure: Parent/Guardian (who is listed on your registration form) will need to be the one signing out your child each day. 3. Helmets are a must for all beginners and for anyone 8 years old and under.
4. We may adjust groupings of children according to level and personalities.
5. **We are a Nut Free Camp; please no nuts or nut products for snacks and lunch.**
6. No Flip Flops or Sandals allowed. Hair pulled back.
7. All items, i.e. lunch box, water bottles, and clothing, labeled with your child's name on it.
8. Bring your skates; if you do not have skates, we will provide them.
9. The skaters are on the ice numerous times throughout the day. Clothes and equipment will be wet/damp at the end of the day. You should air out clothes and equipment at the end of each day.
10. Parent Show starts at approximately 2:40pm on Fridays!! Please attend and bring your family!!

### **SOME YOUNG CHILDREN ARE NOT READY TO ATTEND CAMP; THEY SHOULD BE ABLE TO FOLLOW SIMPLE DIRECTIONS TO ATTEND, SUCH AS:**

1. Going to the bathroom when asked.
2. Eating snack at snack time.
3. Being able to eat lunch in a cafeteria environment with distractions.
4. Communicate any needs to the counselors. It is strongly recommended that your child be able to communicate in English with the Counselors.

- Campers must have respect for one another and camp staff and TCR employees
- **No cell phones, electronic devices, ipods, ipads, tablets, handheld games, etc.**
